## Rust College Named to 2009 President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll



The President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll recognizes institutions of higher education that support exemplary, innovative, and effective community service programs. The Honor Roll's Presidential Award is the highest federal recognition that an institution can receive for its commitment to service learning and civic engagement. Special emphasis this year was placed on recognizing service that helps youth from disadvantaged circumstances graduate from high school and prepare for college.

The President's Honor Roll increases the public's awareness of the contributions that colleges and their students make to local communities and the nation as a whole. President Obama has pledged to make *service* a central cause of his administration and wishes to commemorate the significant role that higher institutions, their students, staff, and faculty play in helping to solve pressing social problems in the nation's communities.

Community service projects such as blood/bone marrow drives, visiting the elderly, revitalizing the community and raising money to support various non-profit and charitable organizations helped Rust become part of the President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll. Tougaloo College, the only other UNCF-member institution in Mississippi, was also named to the list.

## Act Against AIDS!

*Join the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) as they launch a new campaign for AIDS awareness*

#### *From the CDC:*

The U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC) is inviting the students, staff, and administration of Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs), and Predominately Black Institutions (PBIs) to join us and other leaders and celebrities on March 4, 2010 for the release of the newest phase of the *Act Against AIDS* Campaign, ***i know***.

Last year, CDC along with the White House and the Department of Health and Human Services, launched *Act Against AIDS*, the government’s first national HIV campaign in nearly 20 years, to address the HIV/AIDS epidemic in the U.S.

**African Americans make up 12% of the U.S. population, but account for nearly half of all new HIV infections and AIDS deaths.** There has been some progress, but our data now indicate that if left unchecked, 1 in 16 Black men and 1 in 30 Black women will be diagnosed with HIV in their lifetimes. Although African American youth are becoming infected faster than any other segment of the Black community, research indicates declining concern about HIV among young African Americans.

***i know*** is designed to increase the number of young African American men and women aged 18-24 who are aware, and who will talk about HIV/AIDS and myths & misperceptions with their peers, partners, and families.

The ***i know*** event will be held at 5:00 p.m. on March 4, 2010. We ask that you participate in the live online simulcast at [www.actagainstaids.org](http://www.actagainstaids.org). The event will feature host **Jeff Johnson** (BET, *Tom Joyner Morning Show*), the premiere of a Web video public service announcement (PSA) starring **Jamie Foxx**, and feature performances by recording artists, a Q&A between CDC experts and the ***i know*** audiences, and an introduction to the various aspects of ***i know*** (e.g., Web page, Facebook, Twitter, text messaging, participating partners, etc). Also **Jamie Foxx, Ludacris, Keri Hilson**, and other celebs have committed to promoting ***i know*** on their Facebook pages and in their Twitter feeds.
