### Did You Register to Vote?

In 1975, Rust graduate Leroy Frazier ('74) won a federal lawsuit titled *Frazier v. the State of Mississippi*. The lawsuit addressed voter registration discrimination practices against college students who wanted to register and vote in the city where they were attending school. As a result, any college student is now permitted to register and vote in the city where they live while attending any college or university. The ruling changed the results of elections in small college towns throughout the country.
