



## Rust College HEERF Stimulus Grant For Students

The Federal Cares Act provides funds to institutions of higher learning to assist students in defraying costs associated with hardships incurred during the COVID-19 Pandemic. This Emergency Grant Aid provides direct support to students impacted by the change in College operations during this period. The Cares Act Emergency Grant Relief Fund will be disbursed beginning **April 16, 2021** and requirements have been verified.

The sum of \$800.00 will be provided to every student enrolled at Rust College for the 4<sup>th</sup> Module of Spring, 2021. Eligible students must meet the following requirements:

- ◆ Students must have a 2021-2022 FAFSA on file

- ◆ Be registered for Summer 2021 and/or Fall 2021 classes. Contact your academic advisor or Division Chairperson to register (Spring 2021 graduating seniors are excluded).

Upon verification, checks can be picked up at the Cashier's window from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. daily. All remaining checks will be mailed out April 26, 2021 to the official mailing address on file.
